Parish Logo

The PCC has agreed to bring back the previous St Peter's logo for use by the whole parish. This was commissioned by Rev Malcolm Goldsmith in 1980 from the artist Michael Gregory of West Hallam. Malcolm explains the design as follows:

Central to it is a cross, but the cross is implicit rather than explicit - symbolising an approach to mission which does not thrust the cross at people but allows them to see it for themselves. There are many ways into the heart of the logo, suggesting that there are many ways into the heart of the church. Some people may wish to move in and reach "the centre of things", whilst others are quite prepared to move in, but stay more on the edges. All the routes in and out are open - anyone can come in and anyone can leave - there is a freedom which allows people to take control of their own spiritual journeys, which does not require them to pass over any boundary mark, and which allows them the freedom to move away.
