The 'Saturday Matinée' series at All Saints' Church will begin again on Saturday 10th November. This series concentrates on films to commemorate the Great War Armistice Centenary, and will feature 'All Quiet on the Western Front', 'A Farewell to Arms', 'Aces High' and 'Paths of Glory'. All films begin at 2pm, and admission is free. All are welcome.

Remembrance Day, 11th November

In the evening of Remembrance Sunday, there will be a Requiem Eucharist at St Peter's Church at 5pm. Following on from All Souls Day at the beginning of the month, this service will be an opportunity to remember all those close to us who have died, as well as commemorating the sacrifice made by so many in the two World Wars and other conflicts. The church choir will sing Gabriel Fauré's beautiful and reflective setting of the Requiem (complete), accompanied by members of our instrumental ensemble saraBande.

The 10.45am service will accordingly be non-Eucharistic, instead presenting a sequence of prayers, readings and music (sung by the upper voices of the church choir) for Remembrance, including the traditional bugle calls and two minutes silence as we commemorate the 11am armistice that ended World War I, 100 years ago to the day.

Hubert Gale's funeral will take place on Friday 16th November at 11am at St Giles' Church, Church Drive, West Bridgford, NG2 6AY. If you wish to attend the service, the family would appreciate knowing numbers, for catering, so please let Dorothy Mountford know and she will pass on the information.

Renewal of Giving
