### **Diocesan Mission, 12<sup>th</sup>-15<sup>th</sup> September**

In September a group of bishops from the province of York will visit this Diocese to lead a mission. Our deanery will host visits by the bishops of Sheffield and Warrington, the Rt Rev'ds Peter Wilcox and Beverley Mason. We are planning a series of activities which will form part of this mission, one of which will be a parish picnic at All Saints' Church on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September in the afternoon.
